Academic Skills Program: This six week program covers Math topics and English/Reading topics and is required of incoming freshmen students who have been **conditionally accepted** for 2017-2018. Some conditionally accepted students are required to take only the Math or only the English portion, depending on their entrance exam results. Consult your acceptance letter for the program you should take. **Tuition for this program is \$380 - \$190 Math or English only. Registration and tuition for the Academic Skills is due by April 7, 2017.**

For students who are not required to take the Academic Skills Summer Program or Academic Skills English or Academic Skills Math Programs, the following classes are offered:

Intensive Study Skills Program: This fast-paced program strengthens study skills already in place and provides students with an introduction to the daily high school life experience at Marian Catholic. **This program is FREE and open to all incoming freshmen not enrolled in the Academic Skills Program or World History.** The Intensive Study Skills program is strongly encouraged, with registration preferences, for those incoming freshmen whose score on the placement exam was in the 35-55 percentile range. Topics include organizational and time management techniques, reading techniques, note and test taking strategies, and an improvement of study habits. **No absences are allowed for this program. Students register for one of the sessions listed below. Registration closes for this course on April 7, 2017.**

This FREE class will be offered four times this summer and will be held:

Session One:

June 26-30: 8:00 to 10:00 AM

June 26-30: 10:00 AM to Noon

Session Two:

July 24-28: 8:00 to 10:00 AM

July 24-28: 10:00 AM to Noon

Computer Concepts & Information Processing: .5 Credit

This is a required one-semester course for graduation and must be completed by the end of sophomore year. Students engage in hands-on skills that include computer and information processing. It is designed for college-bound students and reflects business practices as well as other areas of studies. Emphasis is placed on reports, MLA formatting, language arts, spread sheets, charts, graphs, and critical thinking with the use of Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Publisher. Students who pass the proficiency test will receive a half-credit. **Computer Concepts is offered during both sessions of Summer School (see above for dates). Tuition for this course is \$300.**

World History: 1 Credit

This course for Social Studies is taken in freshman or sophomore year for students who do not choose World History AP, Human Geography AP or Comparative Government AP as their initial Social Studies credit. **World History runs the full six weeks of Summer School. Tuition for this course is \$600.**

Prior to the first day of class, students need to secure a *World History: Patterns of Interaction* textbook. The book can be rented or purchased online at: www.k12sd.com OR a digital copy can be purchased through the store in the iBooks app if the student has their iPad.
